EUROPE

- ESRB receives notifications to introduce macro-prudential measures The Slovenian central bank wants to reinforce institutional liquidity, whilst Croatia's is trying to introduce a new systemic risk buffer.
- EBA publishes a list of incorrect rules on supervisory reporting The errors refer to the validation rules in its Implementing Technical Standards (ITS). EBA will publish an updated list by June 2014.
- EBA updates its 2014 work programme It covers 10 new topics related to CRR/CRD in its work programme for 2014.
- ESMA publishes statistics on reliability ratings of CRAs Updated with 2H13 data from CEREP (Central Rating Repository), enabling investors to compare the performance of CRAs' ratings by geographical area and asset type.

FSB publishes responses to the OTC derivatives transactions record ۲ The answers are to the consultation on the centralised aggregation of OTC derivatives trade depository data.
