

Financial Regulation: Weekly Update. 18 March 2016

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GLOBAL

· BIS consults on Pillar 3 disclosure framework

It <u>proposes</u> additions to the Pillar 3 framework to include disclosure requirements for: TLAC, operational risk and market risk. Deadline 10 Jun.

• BIS on the Regulatory Consistency Assessment Programme (RCAP)

Publishes a <u>handbook</u> for assessing the consistency of standards as adopted by the various jurisdictions with the overall Basel III framework: i) capital, ii) liquidity and iii) frameworks for G-SIB and D-SIB.

BIS publishes Basel III implementation assessments of Russia and Turkey

It considers that in both countries the domestic <u>implementation</u> of the capital framework and the liquidity coverage ratio meets the Basel standards.

FSB publishes second thematic Peer Rewiew on Resolution Regimens

It <u>examines</u> the range of implementation of the crisis framework. Only a subset of the FSB membership are in line with key attributes. It makes a number of recomendations to address the gaps that will be revised by Dec 2016.

EUROPE

• ECB on the new securitisation framework proposed by the Commission

Response to the request from the Council. It welcomes the Commission's proposals but proposes some amendments.

• ESMA consults on the Securities Financing Transactions Regulation (SFTR)

<u>Level 2</u> measures under the disclosure framework, and includes a cost-benefit <u>analysis</u> (deadline: 22 Apr). ESMA will submit the draft technical standards to the EC for endorsement by 13 Jan 2017.

The EC recognises EU-equivalent regulatory status of US CCPs

EC publishes implementing decision on the equivalence of the requirements met by US CCPs with those



met by EU CCPs. It avoids fragmentation of markets and liquidity.

• EBA on Implementing Technical Standards validation rules

It issues a revised <u>list</u> of validation rules on supervisory reporting, highlighting those which have been deactivated either for being incorrect or for triggering IT problems.

· ESMA issues risk dashboard and report on trends, risks and vulnerabilities

It finds that overall risk in the European securities markets remains high, but with a stable outlook.

ECON meeting

It <u>dealt with</u>: virtual currencies, exchange of tax information and common system of VAT. Amendments to regulations: MiFID, market abuse and improving securities settlement.

Three implementing regulations published in the OJEU

i) On reporting of the <u>liquidity coverage</u> requirement and in relation to the market abuse regulation: ii) with regard to <u>insider lists</u> and iii) timing and format of <u>templates for notifying</u> authorities.

UNITED KINGDOM

• The PRA publishes a consultation paper on contractual recognition of bail-in

<u>It proposes</u> to reduce, on certain conditions, the scope of the liabilities affected by the transposition of Article 55 of the BRRD. It would come into force on 1 Jul 2016, upon the expiry of the dispensation granted to UK banks.

• FCA reforms advice on financial markets to improve consumer access

It proposes improvements in <u>three areas</u>: i) providing affordable advice to consumers (particularly those investing small amounts); ii) accessibility and iii) advisers' obligations and liabilities and redress for <u>consumers</u>.

UNITED STATES

· FINRA on effective practices for digital investment advice

It refers to <u>five key areas</u>: governance and supervision of algorithms, customer profiling, governance and supervision of portfolios and conflicts of interest, rebalancing of portfolios and training.

CFTC on CCP equivalence between EU and US





The US Commodity Futures Trading Commission approves the new <u>compliance framework</u> for central counterparties in the EU including equivalence with EU rules.
