# Financial Regulation: Weekly Update. 22 July 2016

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## GLOBAL

• FSB publishes report on implementation of recommendations to reform benchmarks

It <u>provides</u> a progress report on the implementation of the 2014 recommendations to reform major interest rate benchmarks. It acknowledges administrators' efforts to implement them.

### • Conclusions of FSB's meeting

It <u>discusses</u> vulnerabilities and progress in priority areas: implementation of post-crisis reforms, emerging weaknesses, robust infrastructure, and effective macroprudential policies.

#### • ISDA publishes Bail-in Article 55 BRRD Protocol

It <u>seeks</u> to modify Master Agreements and other contracts to help Dutch, French, German, Irish, Italian, Luxembourg, Spanish and UK entities comply with art. 55 BRRD.

## EUROPE

### • EBA consultation on MREL

Public <u>consultation</u> for interim report (final version expected on 31 Oct) on MREL addressed to the Commission. Deadline to send answers: 30 Aug.

### • EBA publishes final draft technical standards on assessment methodology

To be <u>used</u> by competent authorities in assessing compliance with requirements to use the Internal Ratings Based Approach. It seeks to harmonise supervisory assessment across EU.

#### • EBA launches data collection to support new framework for investment firms

To <u>support</u> EC's call for advise on a new prudential framework for MiFID firms (which should be less complex and more risk sensitive). Deadline to fill templates: 7 Oct.

#### • ECB publishes eurosystem oversight policy framework

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It <u>describes</u> the role of the eurosystem in the field of oversight, replacing the previous framework due to significant regulatory and institutional changes.

#### • ESRB publishes a paper on macroprudential policy beyond banking

Aimed at <u>enhancing</u> policy strategy, regulatory data and instruments needed to tackle risks outside the banking sector. It presents policy options for the short and long terms.

#### • ESMA issues a consultation, an advice, and a statement

i) <u>Consults</u> on asset segregation and custody services under AIFMD and UCITS (deadline: 23 Sept), ii) <u>advice</u> on extension of funds passport to 12 non-EU countries, and iii) <u>statement</u> on IFRS 15, to promote its consistent application by issuers listed on regulated markets.

#### • EC on equivalence and adequacy of auditor oversight

It adopts two decisions on the <u>equivalence</u> and the <u>adequacy</u> of the US auditor oversight authorities. These decisions extend the current agreement by six years.

• Publication of legislative texts in the OJEU

A Commission <u>delegated regulation</u> on <u>recovery and resolution plans</u>, an ECB <u>decision</u> on disclosure of confidential information in criminal investigations, and a <u>Council Directive</u> laying down rules against tax avoidance.

## UNITED KINGDOM

#### • FCA consultation paper on changes in disclosure rules in its Handbook

The paper <u>requests</u> opinions on its proposals for changes in disclosure requirements, to reflect the application of the PRIIP regulation. Deadline for comments: 19 Sep.

## SPAIN

#### • BdE consults on the draft Circular amending Circular 2/2014

<u>Amendments</u> regarding the exercising of regulatory options contained in CRR, to adapt these to that established by the ECB. Deadline: 3 Aug.



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#### • CNMV guidelines on reorganization plans, good practices, and 'closed period' to trade

i) <u>Specifies</u> minimum criteria to be satisfied by business reorganization plans to be approved by the resolution authority, ii) to apply the "comply or explain" <u>principle</u>, and offer clear reasons to depart from corporate governance recommendations, iii) agents with managerial responsibility face a '<u>close period</u>' to trade of 30 calendar days prior to the publication of financial information.
