

Financial Regulation: Weekly Update. 23 September 2016

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GLOBAL

· BIS publishes implementation assessment of Argentina and Korea

Argentina is assessed as compliant in the implementation of both capital and LCR standards. Korea is assessed as largely compliant in capital standards and compliant in LCR standards.

• ISDA publishes recommendation for Financial products Markup Language (FpML)

The latest FpML version focuses on regulatory reporting and is a response to regulatory developments such as MiFID II. Work on the next update is scheduled to start next Oct.

EUROPE

- · ESMA consults on trading obligation for derivatives, and adds ICE Clear Europe to CCP list
- i) Trading obligation will move OTC trading in liquid derivatives onto organised venues. Seeks comments on the calibration of the obligation. Deadline: 21 Nov, and ii) EU firms can now use ICE Clear to fulfil clearing obligations.
- EBA consults on Guidelines on professional indemnity insurance (PII)

For authorities when stipulating minimum monetary level of PII or comparable guarantee for payment initiation and account information service providers under PSD2. Deadline: 30 Nov.

EBA consults on fee terminology and disclosure under the Payment Accounts Directive

Consults on standards setting out terminology for services linked to a payment account, the format and symbol of fee information documents and statement of fees. Deadline: 22 Dec.

EBA publishes Implementing Technical Standards (ITS) on information exchange

Final draft ITS regarding procedures, forms, and templates competent authorities should use to consult each other on qualifying holdings in order to ensure effective communications.

• SRB publishes a guide to resolution planning



The document lays out in detail the information required for resolution planning and the process to draft a resolution plan, including MREL requirements.

ECB and Commission Regulations published in OJEU

i) ECB's Regulation on the calculation of reserve base regarding the application of minimum reserves ii) Commission Regulation amending international accounting standards regulation.

UNITED KINGDOM

BoE publishes statement from Financial Policy Committee (FPC)

Current outlook for financial stability in UK remains challenging. UK banks are deemed able to absorb shocks. FPC expects to maintain the CCyB rate at 0% until at least Jun 2017.

· HM Treasury consults to amend the definition of "financial advice"

Seeks to give firms incentives to develop a more tailored service for consumers by changing the definition towards a clearer concept, similar to the MiFID description. Deadline: 15 Nov.

• PRA issues consultation papers (CP) and a supervisory statement (SS) on insurance

i) CP on draft SS regarding significant general insurance loss events affecting firms' solvency. Deadline: 21 Dec ii) CP on updates to two SS on Solvency II. Deadline: 21 Dec iii) SS on firms' internal models under Solvency II.

• FCA publishes feedback to call for input on Big Data in retail general insurance

FCA found positive consumer outcomes from use of Big Data. However, two potentially risky areas were identified: risk segmentation, and the ability to charge more to some customers.

SPAIN

CNMV adopts EBA guidelines on disclosing confidential information

Guidelines for resolution and supervision authorities on disclosure of confidential information in summary or collective form, and always anonymously. Entry into force: 20 Jan 2017.

UNITED STATES

· FDIC amends definitions and proposes rulemaking to improve resolvability

i) Adopts final rule amending definition of "qualifying master netting agreement" and related definitions, ii) publishes notice of proposed rulemaking on restrictions on qualified financial contracts of certain institutions.





Deadline: 45 days after Federal Register publication.
